

Describing Dining With Antonyms



PRACTICE: There are tons of colorful words we can use to describe our food! Below, you'll find six new vocab words that can be used to describe a dining experience, along with their definitions. After reviewing the vocab words, write your own description of a restaurant you like, using at least four of these vocabulary words, along with antonym clues to hint at their meanings for your reader.

Vibrant: bright and striking; often used to describe colors that stand out or that are rich in hue

Muted: not bright or sharp; subdued; often used to describe softer or less intense colors and/or flavors

Marbled: showing swirls, streaks, or spots of multiple colors

Earthy: having the colors or flavors of earth or soil; often used to describe root vegetables

Eclectic: showing a variety of colors, patterns, flavors, and styles

Hearty: describing foods or flavors that are substantial and filling; often served in large portions
