

### **Extension Activities**

### Keep a Vocabulary Journal:

Students can keep a vocabulary journal where they write down unfamiliar words they come across while reading, watching, or listening to media. They can then decide if the media used an example or a definition context clue and determine its meaning.

Practice With a Word Wall: Create a word wall at home where students can add words with definition or example context clues as they come across them. Afterward, they can practice the words in conversation or writing.


